Your student is invited to participate in enrichment opportunities through our 21st Century Program. Club descriptions are below.

### **MORNINGS:**

**Open Gym:** M,T,W,Th & F 7:00am-8:00am in the Gym, Begins August 28th, 2023. Teacher is Ms. Bingham. Students will gain and improve their basketball and volleyball skills. They will learn vocabulary, rules and team work for each sport.

Open Library: M,T,W,Th & F 7:00am–8:00am Rm. 202, Begins August 28th, 2023. Teacher is Ms. Lopez, Room 202 Students will have the opportunity to work directly with a teacher to gain help on homework assignments in any subject.

Chess: Tuesday & Wednesday 7:00am – 8:00am. Begins August 29th, 2023. Teacher is Mr.Santiago, Room 303 Do you like to play chess or maybe you've been wanting to learn how to play chess? Join the chess Club/team. Lots of fun and a competition in the spring against other area middle schools.

Dungeons & Dragons Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday 7:00am-8:00am Begins August 29th, 2023. Teacher is Mr. Southworth Room 301. The Dungeons & Dragons roleplaying game is about storytelling in worlds of sword and sorcery. It shares elements with childhood games of make-believe. ... In the Dungeons & Dragons game, each player creates an adventurer (also called a character) and teams up with other adventurers (played by friends).

Afternoon students meet at the cafeteria at 3:45 pm and are given a snack before their club begins at 4:00pm. Clubs end promptly at 5:00pm.
